Terms and Conditions

RESERVATIONS & DEPOSIT

Light to Israel requires all interested participants to complete a "Light to Israel" application. Upon acceptance of the application and receipt of the \$300.00* deposit payable to "Light To Israel," the reservation is secured. Any deposit must be accompanied by a completed application mailed to Light To Israel, PO Box 340, Marshall, VA 20116. **Reservation deadline is January 3, 2009.**

All applications will be reviewed by the tour leadership team looking for those participants who would best fit on this special ministry team. If for some reason your application is not accepted, your deposit will be returned in full.

FINAL PAYMENTS

Final payments are required of all passengers by February 9, 2009. Final payments must be made by bank or certified check. No credit cards can be accepted as payment toward the package price.

PASSPORT, AIRLINE AND IDENTIFICATION SECURITY

Every tour participant must be in possession of a current (at least 6 months until expiration) passport. No vaccinations of any kind are required by law. No visa is required of U.S. citizens for entry into Israel.

New security measures require that international tour members fill out an information form to include full name as it appears on passport, nationality, date of birth, gender, name and phone number of personal contact not traveling with you. Our tour application fulfills this requirement.

PLEASE NOTE:

A photocopy of the first page of the passport must be mailed to Light To Israel at the time of application or very soon thereafter.

The passport will be required for identification and airport security so must be easily accessible.

INSURANCE

Optional insurance coverage for trip cancellation and medical expenses is offered through the AIG Travel Guard, Inc. **It is strongly recommended each participant consider coverage to avoid penalties assessed if one has to cancel their trip.** For questions on coverage with AIG Travel Guard, Inc., please contact their customer service number at 866-385-4839 and refer to product #008237.

PLEASE NOTE:

Each participant who wishes to have trip cancellation insurance is responsible to purchase said insurance directly from AIG Travel Guard, Inc. or through an insurance carrier of your choice. Insurance premiums are nonrefundable at time of purchase unless the tour does not operate.

GENERAL

The Light To Israel package price does not include passport fees, drinks, laundry and other items of a personal nature. Accepting substitute passengers for those who cancel will be at the discretion of Light To Israel and our tour company, based on airline ticketing considerations.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION ALL PASSENGERS SHOULD READ

Light To Israel assumes no liability for injury, damage, loss, accident, delay or irregularity in connection

with the services of any airplane, motor coach, or any other conveyance used in carrying out these tours, or for the acts or defaults, financial or otherwise, of any company or person engaged in conveying the passenger or in carrying out the arrangement of the tour. Light To Israel shall not be responsible and does not assume any liability for breach of contract or any intentional or careless actions or omission on the part of suppliers, or any person or entity rendering any other services included in the tour, which result in any loss, damage, delay, inconvenience, accident, or injury. Light To Israel accepts no responsibility for any damage, delay or cancellation due to sickness, pilferage, labor disputes, mechanical or construction difficulties, war, quarantine or diseases, social or labor unrest, government restraints, terrorism, weather, acts of God or any other cause beyond their control. By embarking upon his/her travel, the traveler voluntarily assumes all risks involved with international travel, whether expected or unexpected. The traveler is hereby warned of such risks.

In view of statutory or contractual limitation that may apply to personal injury or property losses, the purchase of personal or baggage insurance is strongly recommended. Such insurance is the sole responsibility of the tour participant. Light To Israel shall not be liable for any loss or damage to person or baggage caused by suppliers. Your retention of tickets, reservations or bookings after issuance shall constitute a consent to the above.

By forwarding of deposit the passenger certifies that he/she does not have any mental, physical or other condition or disability that would create a hazard for him/herself or other passengers. The right is reserved to decline to accept or to decline to retain any person as a member of any tour should such person's health, actions or general deportment impede the operation of the tour or the rights or welfare or enjoyment of other passengers. Light To Israel reserves the right to cancel or change itineraries, or substitute services without notice.
